






#### Recovery-the Global view...RPKs per month






#### Recovery-Domestic does better...

#### Recovery- Ticket sales by purchase date....





# The IE O&D market recovers in 2023 Ireland







- No. of docs processed 81% of 2019




#### And this is how AUG YTD compares...

#### **BSP IE: reminder how we closed 2022 (2018-2022)**




#### **Steady recovery:**

- AUG 2023 (YTD) is only at 86% of the 2019 volume
  - while the market overall is expected to fully recover in 2023, BSP figures are lagging behind

#### **Overview**


- A lot of consultation activity 12 so far this year, with three ongoing
- No expectation of any major legislative changes (slots, consumers etc) until after a General Election
- Not clear yet where Labour stands on key issues

#### **Key Policy Areas**

- Sustainability Focus remains on getting the right policies in place.
   UK yet to meaningfully move to delivery on SAF.
- Consumers CAA Performance Framework for Airline Accessibility
- Wider review of consumer and slots policies expected in Q4/Q
